

## TDMS COVID-19 16-19 Tuition Fund 2020/21



The 16 to 19 tuition fund is a £96 million one-off fund for the 2020 to 2021 academic year only. It is ring fenced funding for schools, colleges and all other 16 to 19 providers to support small group tuition for 16 to 19 students in English, maths, and other courses where learning has been disrupted. The De Montfort School received £1,811.00. At The De Montfort school this funding has been used to support the small group tuition for those 16 to 19 students enrolled in Sixth Form on 16-19 study programmes retaking their GCSE English and GCSE Mathematics, who did not achieve a grade 4 or above at this level by age 16. To support these students an additional GCSE Maths class was staffed over the original plans, the 16-19 funding was used to support the staffing of this class with a qualified Maths teacher. Students were also supported with resources to support them in both English and Maths catch-up during possible times of disruption to normal lessons.
