Dear Parents/Carers

You may be aware of the news this week concerning a young person losing their life in what appears to be a drug related incident. This incident involved a student in South Warwickshire, so fairly close to Evesham. Naturally we send our condolences to those affected by this sad news.

We give a constant message that illegal drugs are dangerous. The drug believed to be involved in this tragedy is MDMA (which you may know as ecstasy). However, many other unsafe and illegal drugs are obtainable all of which present a danger. TDMS aims to educate students on the dangers of drugs whilst maintaining a clear and consistent policy that illegal drugs are totally unacceptable.

Due to dubious manufacturing, people who use or take illegal drugs have no idea what they are taking. There is no safe way to take an illegal drug.

As parents and carers you may wish to take this opportunity to reinforce this message. We believe that a clear and consistent message will mean more young people will make the right choices.
