Year 10 Progress Reports

We will be sending out reports for all Year 10 students this week.

The format of the reports has been changed to align with practice across The Four Stones Multi Academy Trust. We will no longer report using a GCSE 9-1 grade or equivalent BTEC grade for interim assessments. These will only be used for mock examinations and end of year examinations.

Instead, we will now report using percentages to reflect how well students have performed in tests, homework and other assessments set by their teachers. Each student will, therefore, have a percentage reflecting their own achievement; there will also be a class average and a cohort average so that you can see how well your child is achieving relative to their peers. We will continue to report on each student's Attitude to Learning in all of their subjects.
