Dear Parents and Carers

Year 7 Progress Reports

We will be sending out reports for all Year 7 students this week.

The format of the reports has been changed to align with practice across The Four Stones Multi Academy Trust. We will no longer report using a letter grade to denote if a student is Above (A) the threshold of expected progress, at the Expected (E) level, Working (W) towards the expected level or Below (B) the expected level.

Instead, we will now report using percentages to reflect how well students have performed in tests, homework and other assessments set by their teachers. Each student will, therefore, have a percentage reflecting their own achievement; there will also be a class average and a cohort average so that you can see how well your child is achieving relative to their peers. We will continue to report on each student's Attitude to Learning in all of their subjects.

Finally, because we have only recently switched from Spanish to French in Year 7 lessons, teachers will only be reporting an Attitude to Learning grade at this time.
