Year 12 End of Year Exams

As you may know we have held formal end of year examinations for all our Year 12 students across all of their subjects. Given the disruption over of the last 18 months and the continuing uncertainties that we may face in the next academic year, we felt it was particularly important to gather reliable examination data at this point.

Once teachers have marked and moderated the papers, we will issue a report to parents that includes the following information:

- A current grade - that reflects where students are now and includes their examination performance and other relevant assessment information
- A % figure for their end of year exam
- A % for the average grade so that it is clear where a student stands in relation to their peers
- An attitude to learning grade that reflects a students' commitment to their academic studies over the last term.

The Sixth Form Team will review all mocks data and provide information, advice and guidance to students regarding their journey through Year 13 and their plans for the future. Interventions and catch up sessions will be tailored to students' needs so that they are able to succeed and become fully prepared for the world of work, or for apprenticeships or university. Additionally, target work will be set for students to complete in their directed study time at school, supervised by their Senior Intervention Tutor, Mrs Jones, who is on hand to ensure that study skills support is available, and any barriers to learning are overcome. Miss Shepperd, Head of Sixth Form, will contact parents/carers regarding any progress concerns to ensure that appropriate and timely support is in place for September.
